1. The procedure in the state of Indiana is:

Following successful completion of the Transition-to-Teaching Elementary Education program, and the following requirements, completers are eligible for their Initial Practitioner, Elementary Generalist (K-6), Indiana Instructional License:

1. provide passing scores for the state-required content exams
2. provide a passing score for the state-required pedagogy exam
3. provide a valid CPR-Heimlich Maneuver-AED Certification from an Indiana Department of Education approved provider
4. provide a Suicide Prevention Training Certificate
