The Human Resource Management Certificate program at Indiana Wesleyan University seeks to prepare the program graduate for certification and service in the human resources management profession. Certification is granted by the <u>Society for Human Resources Management</u> (SHRM) and <u>Human Resources Certification Institute</u> (HRCI).

SHRM offers the following certifications in human resources management:

- SHRM-CP (Certified Professional),
- SHRM-SCP (Senior Certified Professional).

HRCI offers the following certifications in human resources management:

- aPHR (Associate Professional in Human Resources)
- aPHRi (Associate Professional in Human Resources International)
- PHR (Professional in Human Resources)
- PHRca (Professional in Human Resources California)
- SPHR (Senior Professional in Human Resources)
- SPHRi (Senior Professional in Human Resources International)
- GPHR (Global Professional in Human Resources)

The procedure is:

Following successful program completion, the program graduate will verify their eligibility and apply to take the appropriate exam from SHRM or HRCI.

Students receive certification from SHRM or HRCI after successfully passing the selected exam.

Requirements do not vary by state. Certification granted by SHRM and HRCI are recognized nationally.
